Recently, I was part of a conversation that really made me think. We were discussing the fruit of the Spirit and identifying times in Jesus' life where we see the fruit displayed and how to apply this to our lives. As we moved down the list, we quickly identified peace, and patience demonstrated in His life. We used the Passion Week to see His expression of love for us, but as we moved through the fruit of the Spirit, we stopped on joy. There are many times in Scripture where we see Jesus' joy demonstrated as He blesses the children and accepts the gift of Mary Magdalene, but our conversation was hindered by our desire to read the phrase "Jesus was joyful" or "with joy, Jesus" until a friend opened up his Bible to Luke 10. This familiar account tells of the sending of the seventy-two ahead of their Master, the Lord of the Harvest. The seventy-two returned to Jesus with great joy after seeing the mighty power of the God as they preached. Jesus responds to His disciples and we read, "At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit, said "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and

learned and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure." (Luke 10:24) The disciples had seen the mighty power of God and were amazed that they were called to work and serve in this way. They were rejoicing and the Son was full of joy at what the disciples had seen and experienced-God has revealed the power of His Kingdom to them. As I think back on this conversation, I must ask myself, "Am I filled with joy at the working of His Spirit and the call to serve?" Again and again, we are instructed in Scripture to serve the Lord with gladness. As the disciples and our Lord rejoiced at the work of the God's Kingdom, we should also find our joy in this service. Knowing that "the joy of the Lord is your strength" in the work that He has called us to. (Nehemiah 8:10b)


