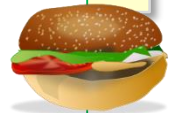

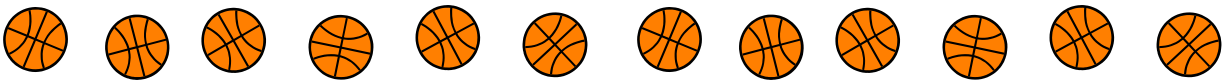


## 2014 – 2015 REGISTRATION
