Dear graduating class of 2018,

You know me well enough to know that my final words to you as a class will include a passage from the book of Isaiah. So for today, I am praying Isaiah 56:7b for you.

***For my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.***

My prayer for you today is that you are known for your prayer for others, that our school is a place of prayer and that you are continually lifting others up in prayer.

One of my most treasured memories of you is any time that I have the privilege to pray for you and to see you pray for others. As you pray, I was amazed and blessed to see the Lord's Hand on each one of you. Your prayers were marked by humility, courage, and kindness. It is when you are on your knees that you are most significant; when you are on your knees that you are most courageous; when you are on your knees that you are most compassionate; when you are on your knees that you are most influential. My prayer for you is that as you are standing for the Truth and laboring for His Kingdom, you are always before the Throne of Grace on your knees.

I have also been praying for you from Paul's letter to the church of Thessalonica. Using Paul's prayer, I am praying for three things for each of you. First that the Lord truly makes you worthy of His calling. You are worthy, not because of your actions or words or thoughts, but because God in His grace calls you His children, makes you worthy, reflecting His righteousness. Second, I am praying that He brings to completion the good work that He began in you- fulfilling His plans and purposes. And third, I am praying that the Lord Jesus Christ is glorified in you- that you bring Him glory and honor in each and every day.

***To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by his power, so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. II Thessalonians 1:11-12***

What a privilege to bring you, the graduating class of 2018, before the Throne of Grace and to know that you are worthy of His calling and that you are and will bring the Lord glory in your lives!

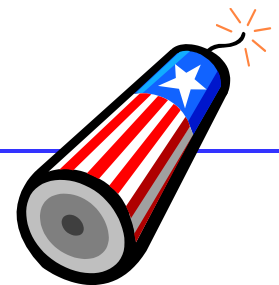

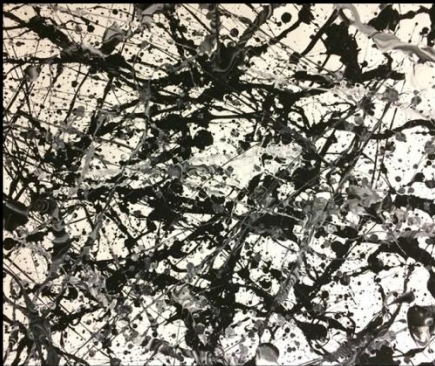
