Dear Cornerstone family,

On my key ring, I have several keys. That is true of faith, without faith we stand outside, longing for the grace and peace that we know is found in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Now without the key, I can try some other means to enter. I can knock. I can call out to see if someone is inside the room. I can even try to pick the lock. But if I have the key in my hand and try these means, I am foolish. The same is true with faith. If I hold the key of faith in my hand, but stand by the door, not entering, simply wishing to enter or knocking on the door for entrance, I am foolish.

Through the blood of Jesus, you have full access to His grace. Just as my keys give me full access to the school campus, your faith gives you full access to God's grace and compassion and mercy and joy. You can enter His presence, cleansed by His blood, righteous, His beloved child. You can stand confident before Him, knowing that even in suffering or sorrow you can have hope and peace and joy. This is His gift to you, His grace for today.

***Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:16***



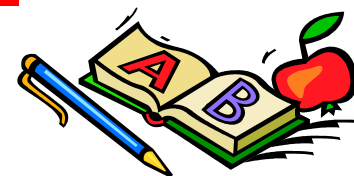

### Cornerstone Prayer Day

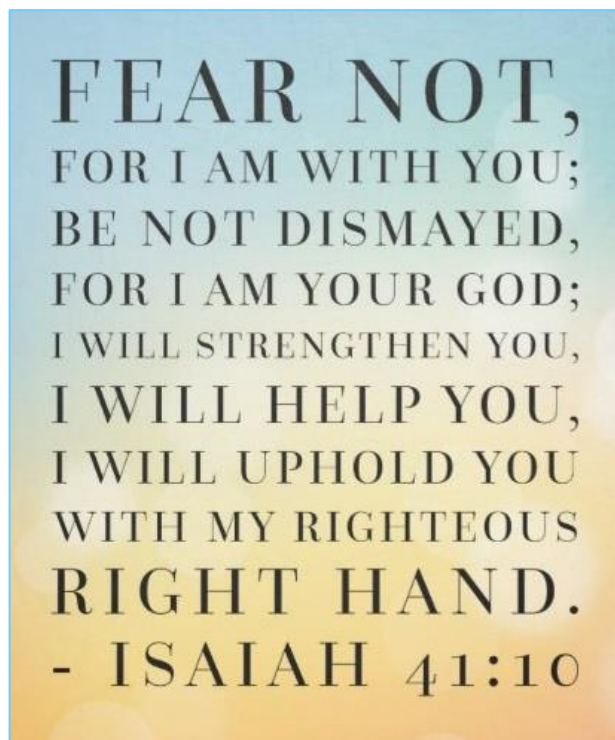
