This Thursday, we completed Chapter 1! 4th graders sharpened their observation skills by comparing a cactus, baby frogs, and a moss ball to determine a common characteristic—the color green! We explored outside to find a living creature then drew the creature in pictures as it

might appear with its population, community, and ecosystem. Finally, we conducted a five-day long experiment to test yeast for evidence of the five characteristics common to all living things. We participated in demonstrations involving water, water bottles, balloons, yeast, and sugar, and even used microscopes! Our yeast experiment notes are in
