When was the last time you received a letter from a friend in the mail? We can quickly recall a text, email, or Facebook post, but can you remember a handwritten letter from a friend? Recently, I received a card with a lengthy letter from a roommate from boarding school. Growing up in Mali, my sisters and I attended a boarding school in the neighboring country of Cote d'Ivoire. I was a little second grader and my roommate was my best friend, Laurie. We would climb trees together after school, share our bedtime snacks, and even cry together when we missed our moms. So it was precious to receive a letter from her. Her card and handwritten letter reminisced our days as little seven-yearolds at boarding school. After reading the letter, I placed it into my Bible along with the notes and cards from other friends and my Cornerstone students. Why save these letters? So I can go back and re-read them, recalling treasured moments with friends and stories of students.

The apostle Paul wrote to the church of Corinth, recalling the believers' testimony in the Lord and reminding them of their call in Jesus Christ. At the end of a school year, I want to write similar words to our students, teachers, and families. 


Mark met his wife, Elizabeth, in college and they have been married for two years. Elizabeth is a teacher at Lewis and Clark Middle School in Bellevue.






Eighth graders, Rhema and Jordan, were selected for Breakfast for Champions in May at the University of Nebraska–Lincoln
