

Administrator's News

For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.

You may have heard me say this before, I believe that God calls to Cornerstone. In my ten years at our school, I have watched the Lord's Hand in the lives of students, teachers, and parents. I have watched how the Lord guides and directs in lives and how He reveals His plans and purposes. I began to see this very early in my time at CCS and during my first year as the administrator, I realized this truth; "God calls to Cornerstone". It was in those first months, that the Lord led me to the book of Deuteronomy. At that time, the school had 86 students, ten teachers, and one receptionist. Our numbers were small, but God's purposes were not.

I recall during those early years, comparing our school to several other Christian schools in the Midwest region. They had hundreds of students, football fields, and spacious campuses. I thought perhaps we were too small, too insignificant, but the Lord began to reveal His plans and purposes for Cornerstone. These plans and purposes were not based on student enrollment or a beautiful campus; those purposes were based in His calling and through His love.

In the book of Deuteronomy, God reveals that He did not select His chosen people based on sheer numbers, in fact, they were fewest. He did not call them because of their economic luster, their artistic talent, nor their military strength. No, He called them because He loved them and that is

the very reason that I know that God calls to Cornerstone. He loves us!

For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for his treasured possession, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. It was not because you were more in number than any other people that the Lord set his love on you and chose you, for you were the fewest of all peoples, but it is because the Lord loves you and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers, that the Lord has brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you. Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations. Now you shall therefore be careful to do the commandment and the statutes and the rules that I command you today. A selection from Deuteronomy 7:6-11

Cougar Care




