

Bible: Continue memorizing the books of the New Testament, students will be tested over these Friday, September 8. We will discuss how God made man in His own image this week.

<u>Math:</u> The concepts for the week are: dividing shapes into halves, telling time to the 1/2 hour, one 1/2 of a number, combining dimes and pennies, ordering coins and bills, greater than less than, subtraction review.

<u>Reading</u>: We will begin reading assessments, and prepare students for reading groups. <u>Writing:</u> both second grade classes will complete the writing activity on how seeds travel.

Spelling: The pre-test for List #3 is Wednesday the 7th. Any words missed should be written five times each, all other words only one time each. If two or more words are missed the student will take the Final Test over List #3 on Friday the 9th of September.
