Medication Information -

- According to the Nebraska State Medication Act and school policy, written parental permission is required for any medication given at school, <u>including non-prescription medication</u> such as Tylenol, Ibuprofen, and cough drops, etc. All medication must be in the original container or prescription bottle. Please send in a completed *Authorization for Administration of Medication* form with the non-prescription medication.
- If your child needs to take any medication while at school <u>for longer than one week</u>, or carries an inhaler at school, parental permission and a <u>physician's signature</u> is required to be on file at the school office. Please send in a completed *Authorization for Administration of Medication* form with the prescription medication.

The Authorization for Administration of Medication form is available at the school office at on our school website.

Absences and Tardies -

If your child will be absent or more than 15 minutes late for school, please notify the office before 9 a.m. Class begins at 8:15 a.m. for Middle & High School and 8:30 a.m. for K-5. If your child is late, you will need to sign him/her in at the office before they are able to go to class. This prevents unnecessary phone calls from us inquiring if he/she is home ill. Notices will be sent home from the office for students who have excessive absences. Thank you for your help.

Did you know...

- The process to order lunches is the same every month. They are, as a general rule due on ParentsWeb the last Thursday of the month with a few exceptions. However, you will be notified multiple times (email, News & Notes, Facebook, etc) of the date. Orders are due for the entire upcoming month and are closed after the deadline.
- If your student is sick or has a school related activity, they will not be charged for the lunch you ordered that day. If they are absent for any other reason you must cancel the lunch at least one week prior on ParentsWeb if you still have access to lunches for the month. If not, you must call the office at least one week prior to the planned absence and indicate that you need to cancel your student's lunch to avoid being charged.
