


Walk-a-thon Kick-Off - by Mrs. Clarahan

Middle and High School Conferences will be on a first come, first served basis and are held in five minutes increments in "The Range". <u>No</u> appointment is necessary.


Please be conscientious of your time with our student's teachers. If you would like to discuss a concern further, please schedule an appointment with the teacher by calling the office or sending an email.



When she is not at school, she enjoys spending time with family, exercising, watching her boys play soccer and volunteering.


