



## MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- 2 packages of college ruled loose leaf paper to share among classes
- 4 college ruled notebooks
- 1– 1½” 3-ring binder with 8 divider tabs for Science Fair [7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grd]
- 1– 2 pocket folder for Effective Writing [7<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> grd]
- #2 pencils or mechanical pencils w/lead refill kit
- 1 package blue or black pens
- 2 red pens
- 2 yellow highlighters
- Eraser (white or pink)
- Colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors
- Ruler, protractor, and compass
- Pencil bag or box
- Backpack (no wheels, must fit in locker)
- ESV Bible

- 1 package graph paper
- Folders [one for each class]
- 6– 1½” 3 ring binders [Art History, Bible, FCS, Journalism, Math, Science]
- 1 set of 8-tab dividers for binders (divided between Math and Science)
- 1– 9x12 or 11x14 sketchbook, ring binding preferable [Art History]
- 1 set of watercolor paints and brushes [Art History]
- 1 set of drawing pencils [Art History]
- #2 pencils or mechanical pencils w/lead refill kit
- Erasers
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- Highlighters
- 1 protractor [Math 9]
- 1 package of blue or black pens
- 1 package of red pens [Science]
- 300 Notecards (lined or unlined)
- 4GB thumb drive w/lanyard [English]
- Scientific calculator (recommend TI-30XII) [Algebra II, Chemistry, Geometry, Physical Science]
- Graphing calculator (recommended TI-83 or 84) [Advanced Math, AP Physics, Pre-Calc or higher]
- Backpack (no wheels, must fit in locker)
- ESV Bible (required for all 4 years of Bible class)
