#### From the Superintendent's Desk

Dear Cornerstone families,

In these past weeks, we have had two significant events as a school family. One, our beloved Pastor Vijay of the Shalom Home in Rajahmundry, India, entered into glory. We have been supporting him and his ministries for the past seventeen years and the students are very fond of him. We pray weekly for him in the elementary chapels and give our tithes and offerings for the children of the orphanage. Not only do we talk about his ministry to the orphans and the schools and the work with widows and lepers, we even know his favorite food and about his pet and that he likes to wear white and blue most. We talk about the next time that he would visit and buying soup for him. And so the news of his passing to glory hurts our hearts even as we know that he entered into the rest prepared for him. Cornerstone will continue to support the orphanage and his son, Robert, will lead the Shalom Ministries in Rajahmundry. I am so blessed by our students' hearts as they grieved this loss, but we know that Pastor Vijay entered glory to the words of the Father, "Well done, good and faithful servant!"

The second event was the tropical storm and flooding in Blantyre, Malawi where our Cornerstone Christian School is located. The neighborhoods impacted include the area our students and teachers live and to date, we have not yet made contact with all of our students. Our Cornerstone family gave generously to the flood relief that our missionaries, Trevor and Kasey Otto will do in the coming weeks and over \$1200 was given. They will be giving food and clothing packets to our Cornerstone families and caring for our teachers and community during this time of recovery. Please be in prayer for this recovery and relief effort in Blantyre and for the safety of our families with the increased risk of cholera and malaria as the floodwaters subside.

Thank you for your part in caring for the widows and orphans in India and Malawi and thank you for praying God's protection and provision and peace!


