As the leader of the nation of Israel, Moses was known for his boldness in approaching God, but also for his humility. As they neared the Promised Land, Moses began to question the Lord earnestly. "See, you say to me, 'Bring up this people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet you have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in my sight.' Now therefore, if I have found favor in your sight, please show me now your ways, that I may know you in order to find favor in your sight. Consider too that this nation is your people." Moses asked the question, "As I lead these people, who will lead me? Where will I find counsel? How will I know where to lead?" The Lord gave His promise. "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

The Lord's promise to Moses is the same promise given to us. He will be with you and in abiding with Him, there is rest. But Moses is not finished with his questions of the Lord. *"If your presence will not go with me, do not bring us up from here.
