Then she called the name of the Lord who spoke to her, You Are the God Who Sees. Genesis 16:13

In the past months, the Lord has brought me to the story of Hagar over and over. The story of the Egyptian slave girl forced into bearing the child of Abraham. I cannot imagine her story, sold in the slave markets of Egypt and taken from her homeland, learning the customs and language of a new people, and then to become the concubine of the elderly Abraham. He had been called by God, the God of promises, the God of faithfulness and truth, and he was promised a son. But instead of waiting on the promises of the faithful God, he and his wife forced their human ideas and plans into the story. They did not trust the promise of the Most Faithful and instead turned to their own schemes and Hagar became pregnant, but God is the One who redeems!

Hagar whose name means "forsaken" was again forsaken by those who were to care for her and after conceiving a child, Hagar was treated with contempt. Running from her home, she collapses by a spring in the wilderness and then the most wonderful thing happens.

"Now the Angel of the Lord found her." Genesis 16:7 The Great I Am, the God of promise and the God of mercy finds her. Oh, to be found by God! She is found and the Lord speaks to her, and she is no longer forsaken. No, she is found. She is seen. Her sorrow and fears are known and she is loved!

Today, you may feel like Hagar, trapped in the sins of others, forsaken by the ones who were to care for you. You may feel like Hagar, unseen, forgotten, abandoned, and forsaken- unloved. But know this- you are seen, you are found by the One who loves you most.

For she said, "I have now seen the One who sees me." That is why the well was called Beer Lahai Roi. Genesis 16:14

The Lord reveals Himself to Hagar, and she sees the One who sees her. Dear friend, you are seen, you are known, and you are loved today. As He was with Hagar, the Lord who sees, is waiting to redeem you and show compassion on you. The Lord of Promise has a promise written for your heart.





Spanish 2 students had to draw a person and label their body parts. Most of them chose a character from a movie or show, so they had fun with it!




