The disciple John in the latter years of his life was exiled to the Isle of Patmos. In his own words, John says that he was "on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus." (Revelation 1:9), sent away for preaching God's Truth and Grace. Patmos was a barren rocky island in the Aegean Sea and it was used as the Roman place of banishment for criminals. With this banishment, the Roman rulers thought he would no longer have influence or communication with the church, and he should finally die of hardship and distress, but instead the Lord used this desolate place to draw John even closer to His glory. For it was in this time of being separate and sent to a place of loneliness that God revealed Himself to John, taking him into the very Throne Room of God.

After this I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven! And the first voice, which I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." At once I was in the Spirit, and behold, a throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne. And he who sat there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian, and around the throne was a rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald. Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and seated on the thrones were twenty-four elders, clothed in white garments, with golden crowns on their heads. From the throne came flashes of lightning, and rumblings and peals of thunder, and before the throne were burning seven torches of fire, which are the seven spirits of God, and before the throne there was as it were a sea of glass, like crystal.

And around the throne, on each side of the throne, are four living creatures, full of eyes in front and behind: the first living creature like a lion, the second living creature like an ox, the third living creature with the face of a man, and the fourth living creature like an eagle in flight. And the four living creatures, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within, and day and night they never cease to say,

"Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!"

And whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

"Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created." Revelation 4

The Lord revealed Himself in His full glory to John over and over and, in his time of exile and loneliness, he entered the Thone Room and saw the majesty and worthiness of our God.

May today you worship the Lord for He is worthy of your praise and adoration and worship. And we can say as the Psalmist Asaph,

**But as for me, it is good to be near God. Psalm 73:28**

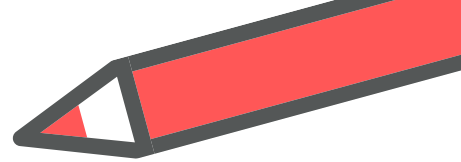
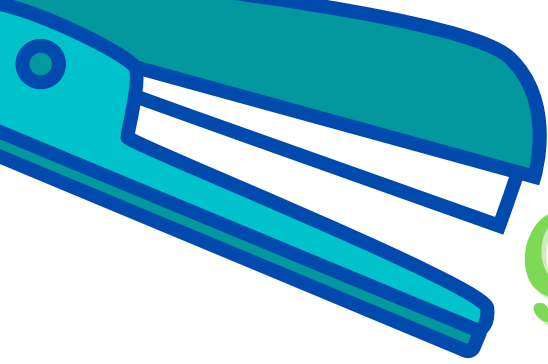

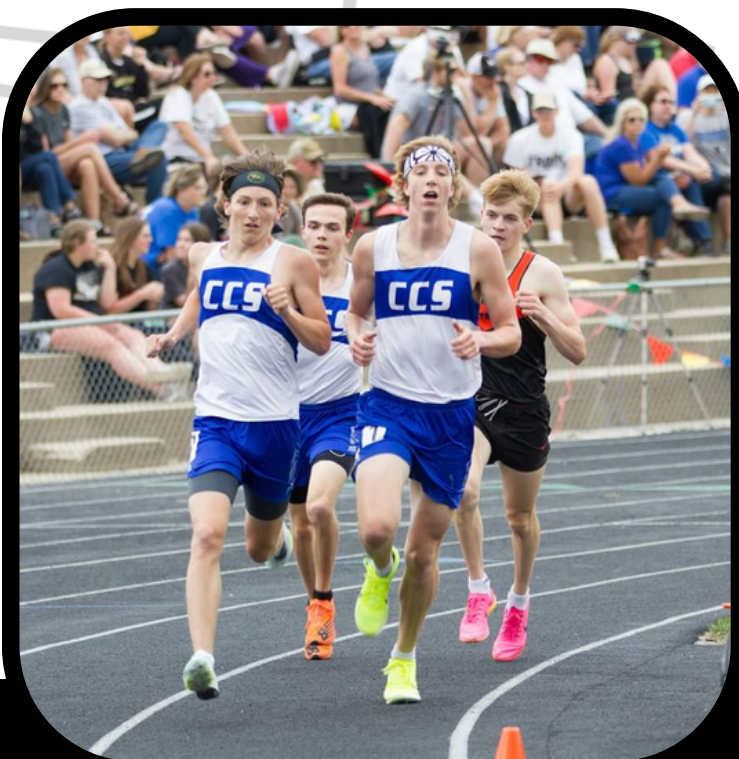




# STUDENT GALLERY
