If we are afflicted, it is for your comfort and salvation; and if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which you experience when you patiently endure the same sufferings that we suffer. Our hope for you is unshaken, for we know that as you share in our sufferings, you will also share in our comfort. II Corinthians 1:3-7

Our hope for you IS UNSHAKEN.

These words echo with God's promise and, in a remarkable way, they declare our trust in the Almighty, Trustworthy God! Paul is speaking to the church of Corinth and through God's grace, these words are for our hearts as well. He is reminding the church of the Lord's comfort and mercy and then he speaks these words to the weary church of Corinth. Corinth was a great commercial center but was also know for its materialism and immorality. The culture of the city was marred by extravagant worship of idols and a licentiousness in the worship of these gods. Although a cultural and commercial center, it was void of the Gospel, and therefore, void of hope.

Paul is calling the new church to live in righteousness and faithfulness. He calls them to be ambassadors for Christ and not to lose heart. And to begin this letter, he gives them this greeting. God is our comfort. In our affliction, God is our comfort. In our sufferings, God is our comfort. He encourages the church that in all things, God is their comfort.

Let these words be true today. God is your comfort. And our hope for you is unshaken, because the God and Father of the Lord Jesus Christ, is your comfort! Glory to God!

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. Romans 15:13

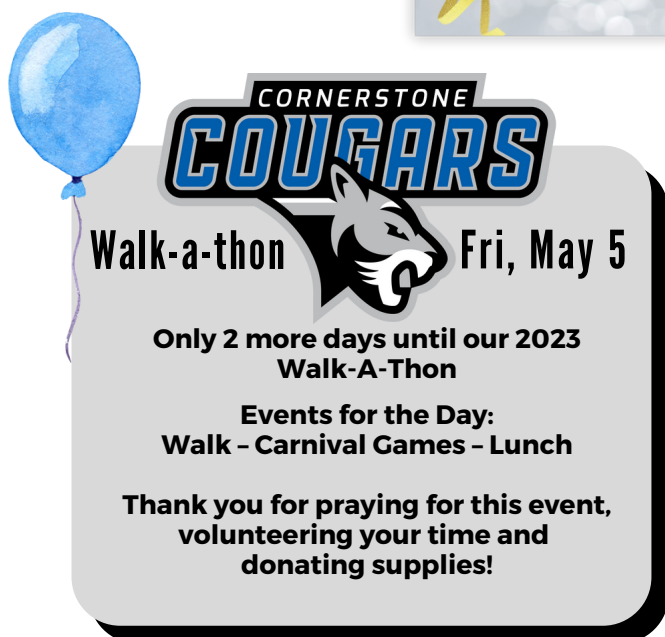

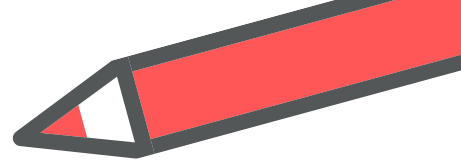


Celebrating 50+ Years IN THE CLASSROOM

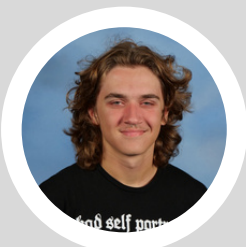

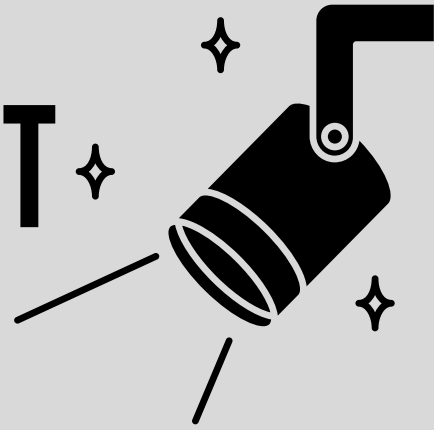
