The great thing in prayer is to know that we are putting our supplications into the bosom of omnipotent love.

Andrew Murray, born May 9, 1828, and entering into glory January 18, 1917, was a South African pastor, writer, and teacher and was known for his commitment to humility and joy in prayer. Andrew writes of the quietness in prayer that comes with hidden time in the presence of our Heavenly Father. Andrew lived during the European colonization of what is today is South Africa, through the Anglo-Boer Wars, and the discovery of gold and diamonds in the region. He lived in a time of unrest and sorrow in his nation, but led his church in grace and peace. He urged his people to seek the face of God in prayer and quietness.

The psalmist guides us into the Lord's rest and His presence that Andrew Murray sought after.

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in His temple.

For He will hide me in His shelter in the day of trouble; He will conceal me under the cover of his tent; He will lift me high upon a rock. Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me! You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, Lord, do I seek." I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living! Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!

This school year we sent out teams to Dallas, Camp Calvin Crest, El Salvador, Guatemala, Sioux Falls and the Webster Conference Center in Kansas. These trips can be very impactful for our students, here are a couple testimonies of what God did this year...



We got to minister in schools in Apopa, the lower income community near San Salvador. Showing Jesus' love to kids from kindergarten through high school. Our first 2 and a half days were spent going into the public school class rooms sharing our testimonies and spreading the gospel (Isn't that awesome to go into public schools to proclaim Jesus?). We also went to an orphanage on Thursday night and Saturday, where we got to interact, and play soccer with kids and show them they are worth it. We were the first trip to go to a Cornerstone international school where we performed a skit, did an art project, and played semaforo rojo and semaforo verde (red light green light) with 4-5 year olds. 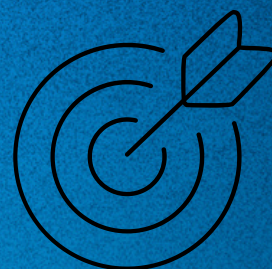
