First grade students practice handwriting and dream about where they'd fly if they were a kite!


If I were a kite, I'd fly to Mt.

If I were a kite, I'd fly to Disney World. It is my favorite and I love the fireworks.





Based on the works of Vincent Van Gogh






5th Grade Radial Symmetry
