The symphony of the nations

Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20

Often called the Great Commission, these verses in Matthew set the stage for the most remarkable worship ever. The Lord, in the days that followed His resurrection, spends this time encouraging and instructing his disciples and His words send Thomas into India, John into Turkey, and soon Paul to Italy. His disciples in obedience to our Savior's commission take the gospel to the nations.

This is still the Lord's instruction to us, "Go, and in your going, make disciples of all you meet." Why? Yes, we are all in need of a Savior and Redeemer and Friend, but He has an amazing plan for those He gathers to His heart. There will be a day when we will stand with the redeemed and worship. The day was revealed to John, the disciple that Jesus loved. He sees the heavens open and....

After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands. And they cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb." All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying: "Amen! Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honor and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!"
Revelations 7:9-12

John sees the heavens open and sees the most remarkable scene of worship, one that has been described as the symphony of the nations, a great multiple worshipping the Lamb. Every nation, tribe, people, and language standing before the Throne!

Today, the world population stands at 8.08 billion and the Joshua Project, <https://www.joshuaproject.net>, estimates that 3.43 billion people are unreached, have no access to the gospel, do not have the full Bible in their language, and do not know a believer in Jesus Christ. Knowing the commission of the Lord to "go to all nations", seeing the great need of the gospel for billions, what is your role?

Years ago, I was told this story. One of my fourth graders was crying that evening at the kitchen table. Her mother asked her, "Honey, why are you crying?" The child's response, "Because I think Dr. Schrag wants me to be a missionary in China, but I want to be a missionary in India." "Oh, honey," was the mother's response, "She would love to have you be a missionary in India." Fast forward eight years, and that young girl had just graduated from Cornerstone and was sitting on the plane with me going to India for the second time in her lifetime as a missionary.

All believers are called to go make disciples. Come be a part of this coming symphony of the nations described by John, "After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb."

I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples. For great is your love, higher than the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth. Psalm 108:3-5

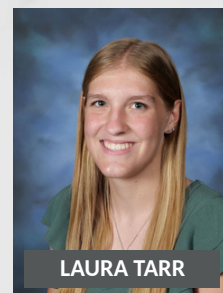
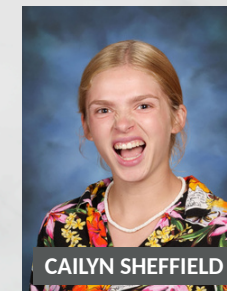
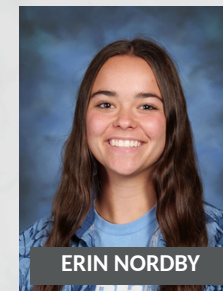
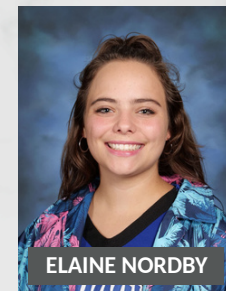
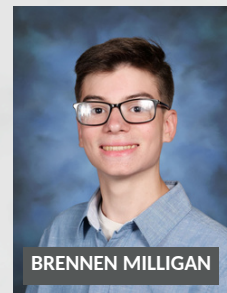
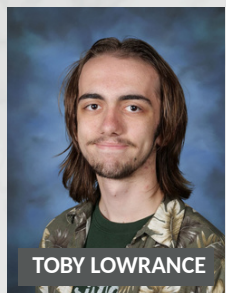
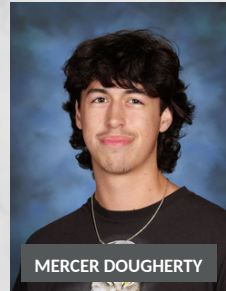
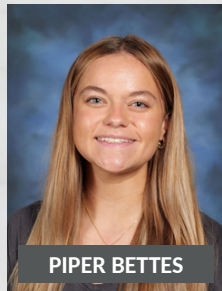


IN THE CLASSROOM



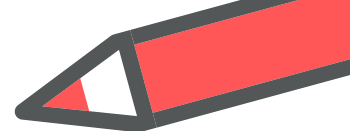
