Each year, our elementary students collect an offering for the Shalom Home in Rajahmundry, India. This orphanage was started by a remarkable man of faith, Vijay Thadanki, and now is overseen by his sons, Robert and David. The orphanage cares for hundreds of children, has three schools for underprivileged children from the streets, cares for widows, trains pastors and missionaries, and ministers in a leprosy colony in the neighboring village. Our giving focus is for the children of the orphanage, and we are blessed to give and pray for them. We look at pictures each week in chapel and talk about the banana vendor who is known and loved by God, about the fun games the children play, and that pictures are often taken on a Sunday when they are not wearing their school uniforms. We talk about cows sleeping in the middle of the street and how widows are treated in India. We pray for the nannies and the ayahs as they care for the children and talk about changing the US dollars to rupees so that the nannies can buy vegetables in the market.

Our students vie to hold the offering box and we check to see if any "seed" has been given during the week. And we talk over and over that God loves a cheerful giver and we pray that the Lord "multiplies" our gifts when it arrives in India. We pray that as the money is exchanged into rupees that they get a good exchange rate at the bank and that the nannies can buy extra rice and vegetables with our offering. And this year, the Lord did a remarkable thing! He multiplied our gifts and offerings here before we even sent the students' offerings to India. Each week as the students give, we count that week's offering and we look at the total for the school year, and just a few months ago, we were excited to see that the total was almost \$300! Then our students continued to give and give; the total passing \$400 dollars and then \$600 and after the final chapel of the school year, we have \$678.86 to send to the Shalom Home. Glory to God! Our students have "sowed bountifully will also reap bountifully". The Lord multiplied our humble and cheerful offerings all for His glory and for the precious children of India!

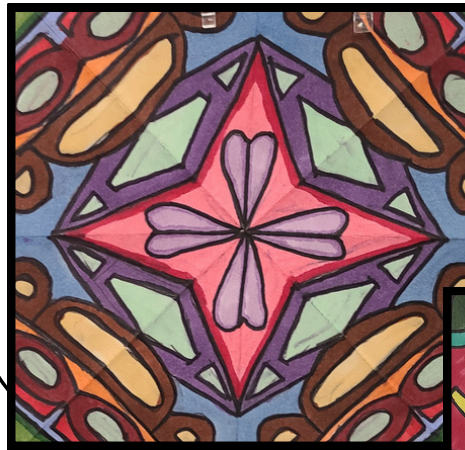

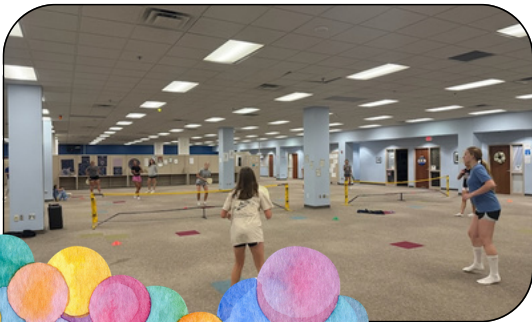
